

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files containing information exchanged between a website and your terminal (usually the browser). They are normally used by the website operator to store information needed to improve navigation within the site or to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user when browsing the web. When visiting the same site or any other site again, the user's device checks for the presence of a recognized cookie so that it can read the information it contains. Different cookies contain different information and are used for different purposes (efficient navigation through the pages of the same site, profiling for targeted promotional messages, analysis on the number of visits to the site).

During browsing, the user may also receive cookies on their terminal sent by different sites or web servers (known as third parties), on which some elements (e.g., images, maps, sounds, specific links to pages of other domains) present on the site the user is visiting may reside.

More generally, some cookies (referred to as session cookies) are assigned to the user's device only for the time they access the site and expire automatically when the browser is closed. Other cookies (referred to as persistent) remain on the device for an extended period of time.

The specific purposes of the different types of cookies installed on this site are described below.

Characteristics and purposes of cookies installed by the site

Technical cookies:

These cookies are specifically used to enable the proper functioning and enjoyment of our sites. For example, technical cookies are used for user login functionality. They are mainly provided by the Sole 24 ORE servers or, where external services such as social networks are integrated into the site, by third parties.

Profiling cookies:

These cookies are used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user when browsing the web. They can be delivered by our servers or through our site by third parties. Companies that offer or advertise their products through this site may assign cookies to user terminals. The categories of cookies used and the type of personal data processing by these companies are regulated in accordance with the information issued by these companies.

Analytical cookies:

These cookies are used for statistical analysis. They improve the site, simplify its use and are

used to monitor its proper functioning. This type of cookie anonymously collects information about user activity on the site and is exclusively provided by third parties.

Options about the site's use of cookies through browser settings

The provision of all cookies, both first- and third-party, can be disabled through the browser settings. It should be noted, however, that blocking cookies that are essential for functionality could make the sites unusable. Each browser has different settings for disabling cookies. List of cookies

A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that a website, when visited by a user, asks the browser to store on the user's device to remember information such as preferred language or login information. These cookies are set by us and referred to as first-party cookies. We also use third-party cookies (i.e., cookies from a domain other than the website you are visiting) for our advertising and marketing efforts. Specifically, we use cookies and other tracking technologies for the following purposes:

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are needed to operate the site and cannot be disabled in our systems. They are usually set only in response to actions you take that constitute a request for services, such as setting privacy preferences, logging in, or filling out forms. You can set your browser to be warned about or block these cookies, but as a result some parts of the site will not work. These cookies do not store personal information.

→ Performance cookies

These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information collected by cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not know when you visited our site.

These cookies allow the site to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services have been added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies, some or all of these services may not work correctly.
